



FY2026 Continuum of Care Competition Notice of Application Deadline Revision

July 6, 2026

The Tucson Pima Collaboration to End Homelessness (TPCH) is issuing the following update to the FY2026 HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Local Competition schedule.

When the local competition was announced, project applicants were advised that both the Neighborly local application and the HUD e-snaps project application would be due on July 15, 2026. Since that time, HUD has not yet released the FY2026 CoC Program project applications in e-snaps. To accommodate this delay while maintaining the local competition schedule and allowing sufficient time for application review, ranking, and completion of the CoC Consolidated Application, TPCH is revising the application schedule as follows.

REVISED APPLICATION DEADLINES

Neighborly Local Competition Application (unchanged)

- **Due:** July 15, 2026
- **Time:** 11:59 p.m. Arizona Time

The Neighborly application remains the required application for participation in the TPCH local competition and will be used to evaluate, score, and rank projects.

HUD e-snaps Project Application

HUD has not yet released the FY2026 CoC Program project applications in e-snaps. Upon HUD's release of the FY2026 e-snaps application, TPCH will announce the federal application due date. The deadline for submission of the HUD e-snaps project application will be the earlier of:

- Fifteen (15) calendar days following HUD's release of the FY2026 e-snaps project applications, or
- August 5, 2026

HUD e-snaps applications will be due no later than 12:00 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time on the announced due date.

All other requirements of the FY2026 Local Competition, including project eligibility, application content, evaluation criteria, and local competition schedule, remain unchanged. Applicants are encouraged to continue preparing all project information necessary to complete the HUD e-snaps application so it can be submitted promptly once HUD releases the application.
